Beyond Treble Bob

Objectives & structure

Purpose

Enable handbell ringers to build on their experience of ringing the standard methods (Plain Bob, Kent TB, Oxford TB), to develop an effective approach towards learning more highly structured Treble Bob, Delight and Surprise methods.

Limitations

The work is restricted to right place Plain and T.B. methods on 6 and 8 bells.

Workshops

The first run of the workshops will be audio based for a blind ringer.

Future versions will have visual accompanying material.

Deliverables

Up to 8 workshops.

Each workshop will have a paper summarising the points made, and suggesting exercises that can be performed in support of the learning points.
